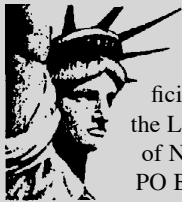

# Gearing Up for City Elections

*We went 3 for 3 in town elections this spring. We're still looking for more candidates for city elections this fall to add to our victories this year. We'll have even more time to help and promote city candidates. The filing period will be upon us soon. Start planning your run now.*

At press time, James Maynard and Michelle Otterson are running for City Council in Keene. We also have libertarians exploring runs for office in Dover, Keene, Lebanon, Manchester, Nashua and elsewhere. We will be making announcements here as the campaigns become official.

Check with your city clerk's office for details on filing requirements. Nashua and Manchester each have over 60 seats up for grabs this year, plenty of opportunities for the hundreds of libertarians living there. Many of those races were won by write-ins, so easy pickings for libertarians.

## Every Race Has an Impact

In particular, School Board and Planning Board, given the power they have over the lives of our fellow citizens and their wallets. Plus, many school boards across the state are very upset with the new federal mandates, another libertarian voice could make all the difference.

Whether you run for City Council, Police Commissioner or Selectman, every race is important, and every potential libertarian win is important. All the races are non-partisan, so there's no Party label to discourage voters.

Success begins at the bottom in politics. Local races are extremely important for several reasons, not the least of which is they have a real impact on our lives on a day to day basis. The other big plus is that these are small districts and *winnable* races.

Let's get people into local office to build the momentum to win

majorities and show people that Libertarian government *works*. We can start creating Free Towns and Free Cities right here in the Granite State *this year*. Let's show the rest of the country that Libertarians can win and govern in NH. Help us build beachheads of liberty across this state.

If you run, the Party *will* help you. We have experienced volunteers and campaign staff ready and waiting. There is money available and PACs which will support serious local races. Party Chair, John Babiarz, will personally provide advice and help for any serious candidate.

### Free market, libertain policy

"The Government is destroying the environment, and many groups are beginning to see the only way to a clean Earth is by bringing about a free market, libertarian environmental policy," echoed Otterson.

Both Otterson and Maynard got great support from local environmental groups during their previous runs for office; Otterson receiving 9% of the vote for State Rep in 2000, and Maynard received 21% for Keene City Council in 2001.

Over 50 people took the World's Smallest Political Quiz, with many people surprised that there is a Party which reflects their views. Many peo-

ple signed up for more information, excited about becoming new activists in the Libertarian Party.

The day was sunny, and warm, with a pleasant breeze, and lasted into the early evening.

We've got two fantastic speakers for you. Our lunch speech will be by none other than his excellency the Governor of New Hampshire, Craig Benson. Our dinner keynote speaker will be long-time Libertarian activist Richard Boddie of California.

Richard Boddie is quite well known for his political activism over the years, having been president of the Student Bar Association in law school; an anti-war activist and community organizer in the 60s; Congressional aide and executive with the American Arbitration Association in the 70s; a fund raiser and road manager for the 1984 LP

Presidential candidate, and he himself also sought the nomination for the 1992 Presidential race. He ran for the U.S. Senate in 1992 and '94 in California, and for Congress in 2000, and served as Chair the Orange County LP 1996-1998. He was the Press Secretary for the Steve Kubby for Governor campaign in 1998.

Boddie is the President and Founder of The Motivators, a professional speakers bureau in Huntington Beach, is also an adjunct professor in Political Science and History at Coastline Community College in Costa Mesa and Garden Grove, California.

At press time, we are still finalizing our afternoon workshops, but we have some great programs planned for you. Perhaps we will even be having a special presentation by the FSP.

At the afternoon business meeting we will be holding elections for the Executive Board, voting on resolutions, party constitution and bylaws changes, and nominating our 2004 candidates for governor, Congress, state offices and presidential electors.

The LPNH sent a small contingent to the LPMA convention on April 12<sup>th</sup>. Old friendships were renewed and new ones made. There was a fair amount of FSP outreach on NH's behalf, including flyer distribution, new volunteer commitments, and even a potential big endorsement for NH. More on that as news develops.

Libertarian presidential hopefuls Gary Nolan and Michael Badnarik had their people at the convention making their case and answering questions. Early assessment is both men would make fine representatives for our ticket. Both have been invited to speak in NH, both at the convention and at Escape to NH.
